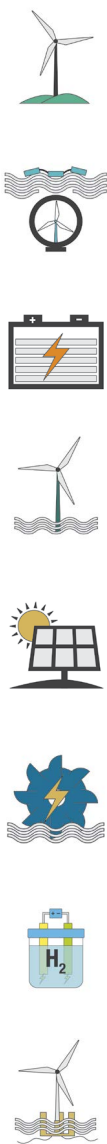




# EMERGENCY RESPONSE: WIND
